1. **ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE:** Horses will be received Thursday, October 8 (Hitches may be received Wednesday, October 7) and released Sunday, October 11, following the show.

2. **HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:** Each horse must have a Negative Coggins test within 12 months of the show date. If coming out of state, Interstate Health Certification must meet the requirements of the State of Georgia.

3. Entries must be **POST MARKED** by September 1, 2020 to insure no late fee. Your **SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER** and **SIGNATURE** are **REQUIRED** on your Entry Form. Payment must be received with entry to be accepted.

4. **LIABILITY:** The Georgia National Fair & Agricenter and the Georgia Draft Horse Association, specifically, jointly or severally, assume no liability or responsibility whatsoever for any damages or injuries to animal or person and/or loss of equipment. Exhibitors are responsible for the behavior of their animals. Unruly animals may be dismissed.

5. **PARKING & PASSES:** All vehicles pulling trailers with horses aboard will be allowed to enter the East Gate. One complimentary vehicle pass per farm and two complimentary admission passes will be issued per horse upon arrival. Vehicles with vehicle passes may park in Lots 5 or 6. All other vehicles must park outside gates and all other personnel must purchase admission tickets at gate. When leaving the grounds, be sure to have your hand stamped at the gate to be able to return the same day at no charge.

SHOW DIVISIONS

HEAVY DRAFT SHOW HITCH HD-S

1. Open to purebred Percherons, Belgians, Clydesdale & Shires only.
2. Eligible for classes marked **HD** and **HD-S**, and age/sex appropriate heavy draft halter classes
3. Show harnesses (scotch collars) required.

ATTENTION SIX HORSE HITCHES & CLASSIC CARTS

4. **ALL ENTRIES** in the North American Classic Six Classes #9, 40 & 101 and/or the Classic Cart Series Class #38, must be members of the NASHHCS and/or the CCS. **Youth Classic Cart** - There is no fee to participate in the Youth Cart Series However to have your points tracked for end of the year awards you must sign up. 5. GDHA MEMBERS CART - GDHA Member owned and driven. (Class #51)

6. Horses may not be cross entered in heavy draft pleasure classes

HEAVY DRAFT PLEASURE HD-P

1. Open to purebred Percherons, Belgians, Clydesdales & Shires only.
2. Eligible for classes marked **HD** and **HD-P**, and age/sex appropriate heavy draft halter classes
3. NO Show harnesses (no scotch collars).
4. Horses may not be cross entered in heavy draft show hitch classes.

LIGHT DRAFT LD

1. Open to Spotted Drafts, Friesians, Fjords, Haflingers, Gypsy Vanners, Drums, Brabants. American Creams, Suffolks & Draft Crosses (must show draft characteristics).
2. Eligible for class # 1, 2, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 11, 14, 16, 18, 35, 36, 42, 44, 48, 50, 103, 107, 109
3. Horses may not be cross entered in heavy draft show hitch or pleasure classes.

GENERAL RULES

1. **HORSES AGE** shall be computed on the basis of a calendar year starting January 1 of the year foaled.

2. **SHOW CONDITION:** Each animal must be in show condition and deemed worthy by the judge to receive premiums.

3. **YOUTH EXHIBITORS:**

- a. Age of youth is based on their age on January 1 of each year
- b. Youth Drivers must be accompanied by an adult in all Youth Driving Classes
- c. **No youth exhibitor may show a stallion in ANY class.**
- d. Youth exhibitors may enter classes marked youth and open only.

4. **HEAVY DRAFT HALTER CLASSES:** ALL MARES and STALLIONS must be registered with their respective breed's association and **REGISTRATION NUMBER MUST BE ON THE ENTRY FORM TO ENTER CLASS.**

- a. Yeld Mare Halter: Open Mare and has not birthed a foal after December 31, 2019
- b. Broodmare Halter: Mare in foal or has birthed a foal after December 31, 2019

5. **GEORGIA OWNED & BRED:** Entrant must be a Georgia resident who owned the dam at time of breeding and currently owns the offspring.

6. **PLEASURE DRIVING** will not be judged by any Carriage Association rules.

7. **OBSTACLE/BARREL CLASS**

- a. obstacle courses will be available when signing for those classes and will be posted at the Show Office.
- b. IN HAND OBSTACLE-This class is for the inexperienced HORSE. Horses entered in this class may not be entered in any other obstacle class.
- c. Same horse or rider may not show more than once in the same class in Obstacle or Barrels.

8. **SPORTSMANSHIP:** Any unsportsmanlike conduct by an exhibitor will disqualify both exhibitor and horse from the show.

9. **BE ON TIME** for each class you have entered.

- a. The show ring gate will be closed after five (5) minutes or a third call by Ringmaster, **Exhibitor will not be allowed to enter the ring.
- b. If you wish to withdraw from a class, please let the Ringmaster and/or the Bookkeeper know in advance so the class will not be held up.

(**Note: *There is no refund of class fees*)

10. **INTERFERENCE WITH JUDGE:** The judge shall report to the management any exhibitor or exhibitors who in any way, whether in person or by agents or employees, interfere with him during his adjudication or manifest any disrespect to him, whereupon a proper apology from such exhibitor shall be demanded. Any exhibitor who refuses to comply with this rule may be excluded from further competition and the management may withhold from such exhibitor any premiums that may have been awarded to him.

11. The show committee reserves the right to add, delete, or combine classes as the committee deems necessary.

12. Any entry excused for any reason during a class will forfeit placing & prize money.

13. **PROTEST:** Protests must be filed in the show office within one hour of occurrence. There is a \$250 fee (returnable only if protest is decided in your favor). Decisions will be determined by show committee and will be final.
