**NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS:** All exhibitors are cautioned to carefully read the following rules and regulations, as they will be strictly enforced. The Show Committee reserves the right to combine, split, or cancel any classes at their discretion. Questions not covered in these general rules will be decided upon by the Show Committee and their decision will be final.

## ENTRY DEADLINE & REQUIREMENTS:

- ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE:** Horses will be received **Thursday, October 6<sup>th</sup>** (Hitches on Wed, Oct. 5<sup>th</sup>) and released on Sunday, October 9<sup>th</sup>, following the show.
- HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:** Each horse **MUST** have proof of a **NEGATIVE COGGINS** test within 12 months of the show date. Horses entering Georgia must be accompanied by an official Certificate of Veterinary Inspection that meets the requirements of the state of Georgia; contact the **GA Department Of Agriculture**, 19 MLK Jr. Dr. SW, Atlanta, GA 30334, Ph: (404) 656-3600 or (800) 282-5852
- EARLY ENTRIES** must be **postmarked** by **SEPTEMBER 1<sup>st</sup>** and must include the following to be considered fully complete:
  - Separate **ENTRY FORM** for each horse; hitches may use a single form;
  - Signed **WAIVER(S)** of Liability (signed **by owner & EACH exhibitor**);
  - Valid **PAYMENT** to cover show fees.
- EARLY BIRD RAFFLE:** Register **BEFORE** the deadline and we'll enter your name into a drawing for a \$250 Visa Gift Card!! (*Complete entry must be received by 9/1/22 to qualify*)
- SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER & SIGNATURE** of owner **REQUIRED** for premium checks.
- CANCELLATIONS OR CHANGES** must be made no later than **SEPTEMBER 15, 2022**.
- REFUNDS** will NOT be given.
- ADDS/SCRATCHES:** All **SCRATCHES & ADDS** MUST BE MADE IN THE SHOW OFFICE prior to the start of the session, **NO EXCEPTIONS**. Show Office hours will be posted and announced. **THERE WILL BE NO REFUND OF CLASS FEES.**
- PAYMENT** for all show fees must be made by **CHECK** payable to: **Georgia Draft Horse Association**, or by **CREDIT/DEBIT CARD** using online payment link [paypal.me/gdha](https://www.paypal.com/gdha). *\*NOTE -online payments subject to a 4% transaction fee; there is a \$35 NSF fee for any returned checks.*
- EXHIBITOR INFORMATION PACKETS**, including stall assignments and parking pass/gate entry information, will be emailed to each exhibitor no later than (7) days before the Show date.

**HORSE FEE** ----- **\$10 per horse**  
**CLASS FEE** ----- **\$10 per class**  
**STALL FEE** ----- **\$50 per stall** (for 1-4 nights, including tack stalls)  
\*All horses **MUST** be stabled in barn & **stall fees paid** prior to participation in show.  
**PINE SHAVINGS** ----- **\$7 per bag**  
\*Two (2) bags of shavings per stall will be provided; additional bags of shavings may be purchased directly from the Fairgrounds online at [www.showshavings.com](http://www.showshavings.com)  
**RV CAMPING HOOKUPS** ----- **\$40-\$55 per day\***

## SHOW DIVISIONS

### (HD-S) = HEAVY DRAFT SHOW HITCH

- Open to purebred Belgians, Clydesdales, Percherons, Shires **ONLY**.
- Eligible for classes marked (HD) and (HD-S), and age/sex appropriate halter classes.
- All drivers and attendants must be appropriately dressed (no jeans).
- **SHOW HARNESSSES** (Scotch Collars) **REQUIRED**.
- Horses may **NOT** cross-enter into Heavy Draft Pleasure (HD-P) classes.

### (HD-P) = HEAVY DRAFT PLEASURE

- Open to purebred Belgians, Clydesdales, Percherons, & Shires **ONLY**.
- Eligible for classes marked (HD) and (HD-P) and age/sex appropriate halter classes
- **NO** show harnesses permitted (No Scotch Collars)
- Horses may **NOT** cross enter into Heavy Draft Show Hitch (HD-S) classes.

### (LD) = LIGHT DRAFT/DRAFT CROSS

- Open to all other breeds of Draft horses, Draft ponies and crosses (must show Draft characteristics) including, but not limited to: Brabants, Drums, Friesians, Gypsy Vanners, Haflingers, Spotted Drafts, Sugarbushes, and Suffolks.
- Horses may **NOT** cross-enter into Heavy Draft Show Hitch (HD-S) or Pleasure (HD-P).

## GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS:

- HORSE'S AGE** determined based on a calendar year, starting January 1<sup>st</sup> of year foaled.
- SHOW CONDITION:** Each animal must be in show condition to receive premiums.
- BACK NUMBERS** will be assigned to each entry. This number will identify horses in the show and must be displayed properly when entries are being judged. Any entry that does not wear the correct back number for the class they are entered in will **NOT** receive any premiums earned in that class.
- PROPER SHOW ATTIRE** is required to be worn by exhibitors (including assistants/headers) while in the show ring. Dress appropriately; exhibitors and headers should look neat and clean. (NO blue jeans, shorts, flip-flops, or Crocs<sup>®</sup> permitted).
- NO CAMPING** IS ALLOWED IN OR AROUND THE BARN. Only **ONE** (1) individual may spend the night inside the barns to tend to animals and must do so within assigned stalls.
- BARN AISLES** must remain clear for both safety and appearance.
- NO COOKING** is allowed inside the barns to comply with local fire codes.
- NO DOGS** ARE ALLOWED IN THE PERDUE ARENA, STAGING AREAS OR IN OR AROUND PRACTICE ARENA. Due to the **NO PET POLICY** on the Fairgrounds, dogs of horse show exhibitors are restricted to stabling area of horse show complex, must be restrained by a leash, and may **NOT** be tied in barn aisle. Exhibitors must clean up after their dogs. This rule will be strictly enforced with a fine of \$200 imposed to anyone in violation.
- NO UNAUTHORIZED ATVs**, Golf Carts, Motorcycles or Bicycles allowed on grounds. Skateboards, Scooters, Roller Skates, Hover Boards, Roller Blades, and other similar mechanical equipment strictly prohibited on the Georgia National Fairgrounds.
- NONCOMPLIANCE:** Exhibitors not cooperating with security personnel or officials of the Show in all matters of policy, including parking, will have their entries canceled and will be ordered to leave the grounds immediately.

**49. STALL DECORATING CONTEST:** 1st-3rd place trophies & ribbons awarded for Best Decorated Stall, sponsored by Willow Bend Farms and Berry Oaks Farm. Judging and awards presentation for the contest will take place on Saturday afternoon.

**50. SPECIAL AWARDS** will be presented in honor and memory:

- The **Ken Janes Memorial Trophy** awarded to the winner of Men's Supreme Cart class.
- The **Renon Pruiett Memorial Trophy** awarded to winner of Four-Horse Hitch class.
- The **Karen McQueen Memorial Trophy** awarded to winner of HD Pleasure Driving.
- The **Rebecca Cannon Under Saddle Achievement Award** will be given to the winner in each HD-S Adult Walk/Trot Under Saddle classes (English & Western).
- The **Tom Johnson Sportsmanship Award** will be given to the individual who receives the highest number of nominations by their peers and show staff. Nominations should include a brief explanation of how the individual has displayed sportsmanship; must be submitted to Show Office by end of Saturday.
- The **Pia Johansson/Kim Smith Memorial Youth Challenge Awards** is a high-point competition for youth exhibitors (age 18 & under) with separate divisions for Heavy Draft and Light Draft/Draft Cross.
  - Youth exhibitors may compete with any horse and may participate in both HD and LD classes throughout the show but may only *earn points* towards the Challenge in ONE division (Heavy Draft OR Light Draft).
  - Exhibitors may compete in any of the qualifying classes, but **MUST** declare which division they are competing for points in.
  - Qualifying classes for the **HEAVY DRAFT (HD) Division:** (HD) Youth Showmanship, (HD) Youth English Under Saddle Walk/Trot, (HD) Youth Western Under Saddle Walk/Trot, (HD-S) Youth Classic Cart, and (HD-P) Youth Cart.
  - Qualifying classes for the **LIGHT DRAFT (LD) Division:** (LD) Youth Showmanship, (LD) Youth English Under Saddle Walk/Trot, (LD) Youth Western Under Saddle Walk/Trot, and (LD) Youth Pleasure Driving
  - POINTS** will be counted for each placing as follows: 1<sup>st</sup> place (10 points), 2<sup>nd</sup> place (9 points), 3<sup>rd</sup> place (8 points), 4<sup>th</sup> place (7 points), 5<sup>th</sup> place (6 points), 6<sup>th</sup> place (5 points), 7<sup>th</sup> place (4 points), 8<sup>th</sup> place (3 points), 9<sup>th</sup> place (2 points), and 10<sup>th</sup> place (1 point). All remaining exhibitors will earn 1 point.
  - In the event of a tie, the youth with the greatest number of 1<sup>st</sup> places will win. If a tie still remains, the youth with the greatest number of 2<sup>nd</sup> places will win, so on.
  - Total of points for each exhibitor will be tallied after all Youth classes have been finalized. Awards will be presented during Sunday evening's show and all youth exhibitors must be present to receive their award and medal.
  - Youth exhibitors who wish to participate in the Challenge and have their points calculated must submit an enrollment form upon check-in at the show office.

## CLASS DESCRIPTIONS & RULES

**BE SAFE!** Check that all riding tack, harness and equipment is clean and in good repair. Headers are required during hitching. All classes shall be judged on turnout and appearance as appropriate to the class, riding/driving ability, willingness and response of the animal(s), and teamwork between horse(s) and rider/driver. Any entry may be excused from show ring or fairgrounds if the Judge deems them hazardous to other participants.

**HEAVY DRAFT HALTER CLASSES** will follow the standard course for a halter class and will be judged on the presentation and confirmation of horse. Shoeing of halter horses is optional. Whip person is permitted but not required. Appropriate decoration is encouraged. Exhibitors may have multiple entries per class. Classes may be combined at the discretion of Show Committee. All mares and stallions **MUST** be registered with their respective breed's association; Registration number **REQUIRED** on entry form.

- **YELD MARE:** Mare did not produce a foal in the given calendar year (after 12/31/21)
- **BROODMARE:** Mare has birthed a foal in the given calendar year (after 12/31/21)

- **GET OF SIRE:** Two (2) or more horses from the same sire
- **PRODUCE OF DAM:** Two (2) or more horses from the same dam
- **GEORGIA OWNED & BRED:** Entrant must be Georgia resident who currently owns or previously owned the dam at time of breeding, and currently owns the offspring

**CHAMPIONSHIP CLASSES** are limited to FIRST & SECOND place animals only.

**OBSTACLE CLASSES:** Course diagrams will be posted prior to the start of the show;

- Judged on performance and accurate completion within the allotted time limit;
- Exhibitors should look neat and clean; blue jeans are acceptable for "fun" classes.
- Exhibitor will be asked to move on to next obstacle after two (2) refusals;
- In the event of a tie, the faster time will win;
- IN-HAND OBSTACLE** is intended **ONLY** for young and/or inexperienced horses. Horses entered in this class may **NOT** enter any Obstacle Under Saddle or Obstacle Cart class;
- The same HORSE may not show more than **ONCE** in Barrel Racing.
- The same HORSE may not show more than **ONCE** in any one Obstacle class.

**SHOWMANSHIP** classes shall be judged on the handler's ability; the horse is not to count.

**YOUTH DECORATING CLASS:** Youth exhibitors must provide their own horse, holder, equipment, and decorations. Exhibitors must roll a mane, tail and foretop in 30 minutes. Class will be judged on neatness/tightness of mane, tail and foretop and overall appearance of the horse.

**YOUTH SHOWMANSHIP & DRIVING** classes shall be judged on the youth exhibitor's showmanship ability, the horse is not to count.

**UNDER SADDLE CLASSES:** Horses and riders in under saddle classes should be dressed and tacked appropriately to the discipline in which they are showing. Horses may not be shown in blinder bridles. Participants should enter ring at a trot. Horse will be shown both directions of the ring with gaits at the discretion of the judge. Passing slower horses is permitted. Horses will lineup, should stand quietly and will be asked to back.

**PLEASURE DRIVING:** Horses must be harnessed to appropriate 2-wheel vehicle, no Scotch collars are permitted; class will **NOT** be judged by any carriage association rules.

**NORTH AMERICAN OPEN SIX HORSE HITCH CLASSIC:** Membership to the North American Six Horse Hitch Classic Series (\$50/year) is required to enter, or a Classic Series Show Pass may be obtained for a \$25 fee (paid directly to the Show) which allows entry to ONE show per year for the Six-Horse Hitch Classic Series.

**CLASSIC CART:** Membership to the Classic Cart Series (\$50/year) required to enter or a Classic Series Show Pass may be obtained for a \$25 fee (paid directly to the Show) which allows entry to ONE show per year for the Classic Cart Series.

**YOUTH CLASSIC CART:** There is **NO FEE** to participate in Youth Cart Series, but **MEMBERS MUST REGISTER ONLINE** each year for points to be tracked.

**GDHA MEMBERS' CART:** Class is limited to members of the Georgia Draft Horse Association **ONLY**; entries must be owned and driven by a GDHA member.
